#### FSAs for Grades 4 & 7

Each year, the Ministry of Education requires school districts to conduct the Provincial Foundation Skills Assessment (FSA). This year, the FSAs will take place in October and November. The FSA is an annual province-wide assessment of all Grade 4 and 7 students' academic skills and is designed to provide parents, teachers, schools, school districts and the Ministry of Education and Child Care with important information on how well students are progressing in the foundation skills of Reading, Writing and Numeracy. All families were sent a district letter on Sept. 21, outlining more details about the FSAs. Please reach out to school administration with any questions.
