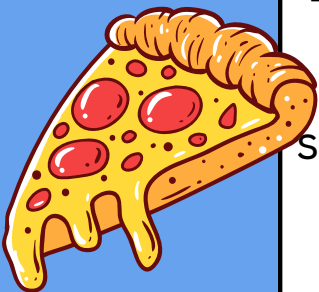
Be prepared for the weather

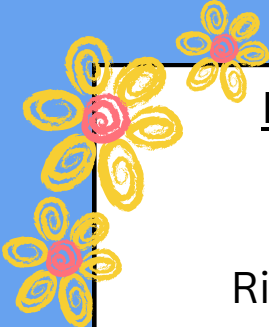

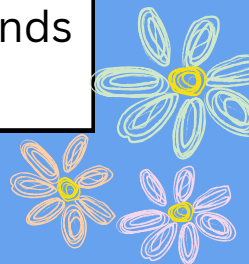
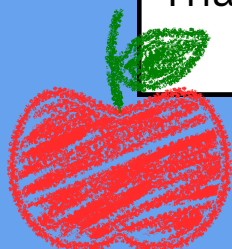
Kindergarten Registration for Next School Year **(For children born in 2021)**

Richmond School District 38 is excited to welcome Kindergarten registration applications for children born in 2021, turning 5 in 2026. These children will begin Kindergarten in September 2026.

Online registration opens on November 1, 2025. Please visit our district's website: <https://sd38.bc.ca/student-registration/kindergarten-registration>, for more information about our online registration process, required documents, important dates, and FAQs. We encourage families to complete their registration within the Priority 1 registration window, which spans from November to January, to maximize their chances of securing a spot at their catchment school. All registration applications received any time during the Priority 1 registration period will receive placement decisions by February 6, 2026.

Finally, there will be a Kindergarten Information Evening for parents of students with disabilities and diverse abilities on Zoom held on November 5th from 5:30 – 6:30pm. A link to the Zoom is available on our District website <https://sd38.bc.ca/student-registration/kindergarten-registration>.

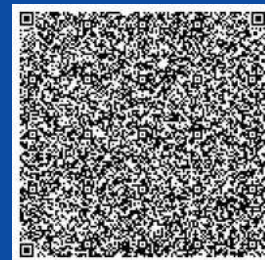

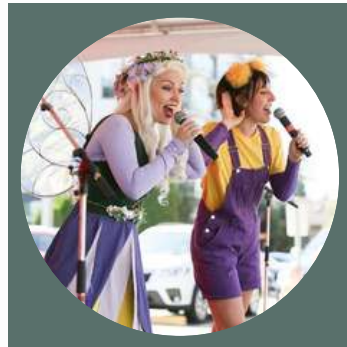
