

CLASS PLACEMENTS NEXT YEAR

In June, staff spends considerable time determining the placement of students in classes for



the next school year. There are many factors that are important considerations in this process. These classes are subject to change in September, subject to enrolment numbers through the summer and during the first week of school.

Student considerations include:

- *Learning style, strengths and needs
- *Degree of independence in work habits
- *Social and personal characteristics
- *Previous year's placement
- *Parent knowledge of their child

If you have information based on the factors listed above that you would like us to consider when placing your child in a class for next year, please take this opportunity to submit this information to the office in writing by next <u>Friday</u>, <u>June 10th</u>. This information will be shared with teachers during the meetings held to create tentative class placements. Please do not request specific teachers, as at this time we do not know which teacher will be teaching which grades next year.


