Registration Fees

A non-refundable \$50 registration fee is due when registering. The year's fees are divided into 10 equal payments and may be paid by cash, debit, Visa, MasterCard, American Express or cheque. Payments are due one month in advance, starting August 1 to May 1.

After Care Only: \$451.65/month

Before and After Care: \$493.85/month

About Cambie's Out of School Care

Daily Schedule

The Out of School Care program is split into three age groups:

- Junior - Kindergarten-Grade 1
- Middle - Grades 1-2
- Senior - Grades 3-7

All programs adhere to government regulations and work closely with Richmond Health Services.

Programs operate from September through June, Monday to Friday, 7:00 to 8:45am (Before Care) and school dismissal to 6:00pm (After Care).

Free time (games, puzzles, arts and crafts, floor toys, outside play etc. available each day)

4:00pm

Snack time

4:15pm

Activities begin (choice of physical activity or non-physical offered each day)
