

## FEEDING FUTURES AND AFFORDABILITY

Recently, the provincial government announced a new Feeding Futures School Program Fund, designed to assist schools in the development and enhancement of school meal programs and other nutritional supports for students.

### **GETTING READY FOR HALLOWEEN**

This is the time of the year when we are thinking about Halloween costumes and celebrations. We are

asking that you follow certain guidelines when thinking about a costume for your child at school:

- 1) Culture (Indigenous regalia, dreadlocks, etc.), race (black face/brown face, etc.) and religion (nun, priest, hijab, etc.) are NOT a costume: It is important to keep in mind that we need to be sensitive to groups that have been marginalized through mimicry and cultural appropriation during Halloween and other 'dress up' events.
- 2) **Gender is not a costume**: gender switching and stereotyping for humour or to mock could be hurtful.
- 3) Weapons, even plastic ones, will not be accepted as accessories for costumes at school. They pose a threat to safety for students when misused.
- 4) Let's think about our ecological footprint: is there a costume that could be re-used or borrowed from a friend? Could you perhaps consider making your costume yourself from recycled materials?

We look forward to seeing our students' costumes on October 31!



## WEST COAST RECESS AND LUNCH

Just a reminder that children at Mitchell will be going outside rain or shine during recess and lunch breaks. We

believe that being able to go outside, breathe lots of fresh oxygen and move around is very good for children's well-being and ability to learn. A well-known Norwegian quote tells us "There is no bad weather, only bad clothing." With this in mind, please make sure your child has adequate clothing for outside, even in the rain. Please provide them with a change of socks and shoes, rainproof coat with hood or hat and possibly an umbrella.
