

At Mitchell Elementary and across the District, we access children's school information directly online. SD38 has initiated the **MyEducation BC PARENT PORTAL** which will allow parents and/or guardians to access attendance, term grades, report cards and other information on their child(ren).

Each parent/guardian will have their own separate account, and can view the following:

- Attendance Information
- Contact Information
- Student Demographic Information
- Published Report Cards
- Transcript Information

You would have received an email either last year, or just shortly after you started at Mitchell from <u>"sysadmin@myeducation.gov.bc.ca"</u> with your login ID and temporary password. Instructions on how to login and navigate the Parent Portal can be found on our school website.

Access the Parent Portal

- The first login must be done from a workstation, laptop or computer. Do not use an iPad, tablet, or cell phone. After the initial log in you may use any device to access your parent portal account.
- Enter the login ID and password provided in the MyEd BC email.
- The first time you log on to your account you will be asked to change your password.
- ** Please print or download the report card each term as they will be removed from MyEd approximately one month after being posted. **



PARENT MINISTRY SURVEY

During the months of January to April, School District # 38 is participating in the 2024 Ministry of Education Electronic Anonymous Student Learning Survey Project in cooperation with all other school districts throughout the province.

Parents/Guardians/Caregivers can complete the online Anonymous Student Learning Surveys **any time before 11:59 pm May 3rd, 2024**, providing immediate results to the school and the district.

For 2024: Students in Grades 4 & 7 complete the survey; Parents/Guardians/Caregivers of Grade 4 & 7 complete the survey; and all Staff associated with a School complete the survey. Schools may survey other grade levels after finishing the grades above.

To complete the survey:

- Go to any computer that has an up-to-date internet browser access at home, work, or school.
- 2. Go to www.bced.gov.bc.ca/sat_survey/access.htm
- Under the section Direct Access no logon number required select:
 - District: the name of your child's district
 - School: the name of your child's school
 - Language: the language of your choice
- 4. Complete the survey by clicking on the appropriate circle to answer each question. Move to the next set of questions by clicking on the right arrow in the bottom right corner of the screen. Click on the left arrow to navigate backwards.
- 5. When you are finished the survey, you will get a message "Thank you for sharing your views".
- 6. Once complete, your school will have the results immediately.
