E-BIKES AND E-SCOOTERS ON SCHOOL GROUNDS

Please note that e-bikes and e-scooters are not allowed on sidewalks. We are asking you to dismount and walk your bikes and scooters prior to entering the sidewalk. This is for everyone's safety.

early, or if you will be going on an extended vacation. If you intend on returning to school late in September,



WEST COAST RECESS AND LUNCH
