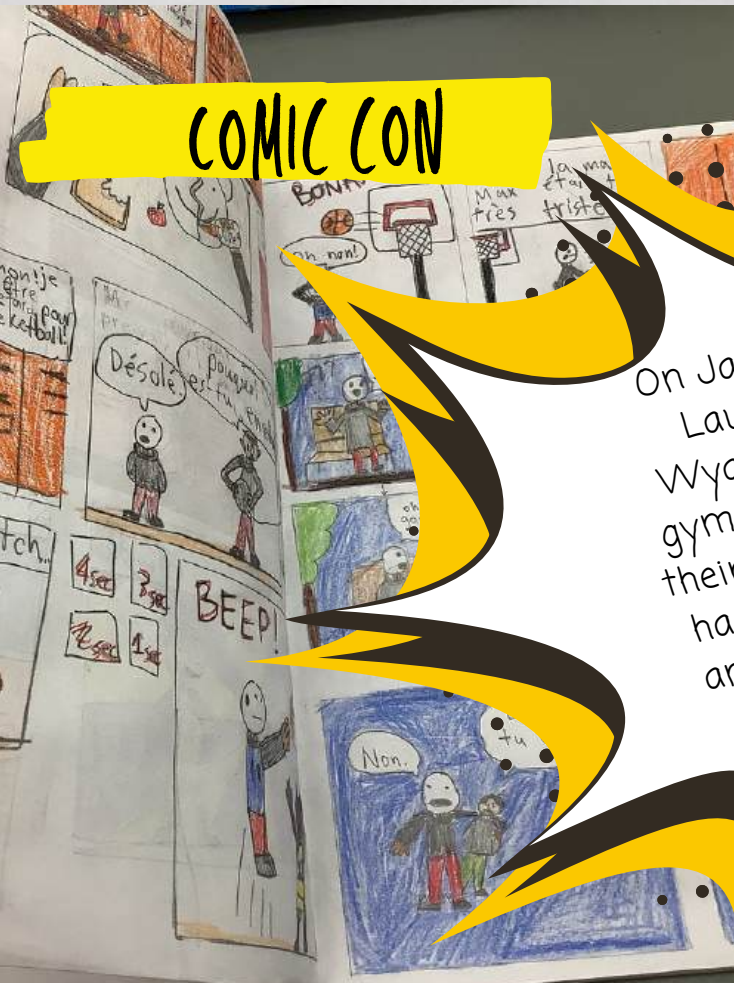
## WORD FROM THE PRINCIPAL
