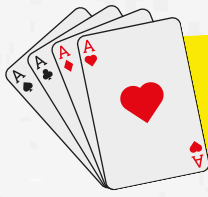




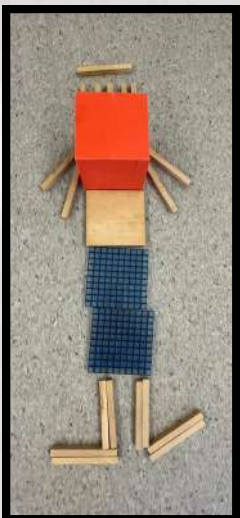
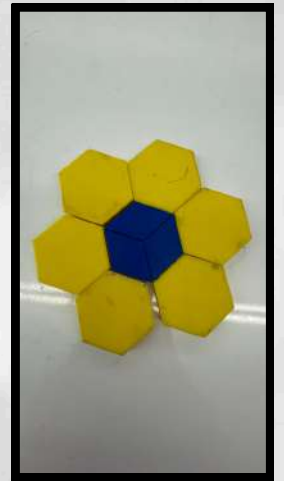
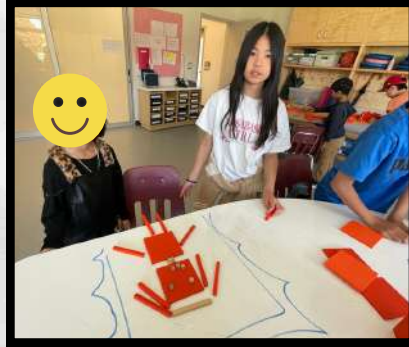
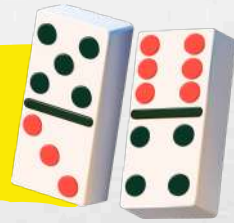
BUILDING CONFIDENCE THROUGH NUMERACY

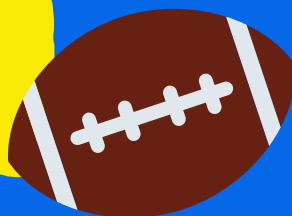
EARTH RANGERS PRESENTATION



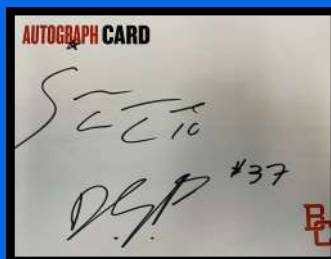
