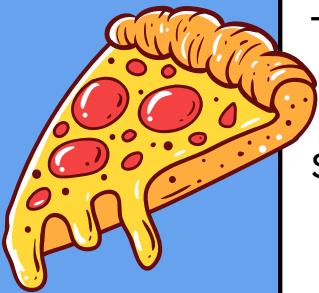
Be prepared for the weather

Halloween Costumes



On Friday, October 31, students may choose to wear a costume to school for Halloween. There is absolutely no obligation for anyone to dress up for the day. If your child wears a costume to school, please consider the following guidelines to ensure it is school appropriate:

- 1) Culture (Indigenous regalia, dreadlocks, etc.), race (black face/brown face, etc.) and religion (nun, priest habit, hijab, etc.) are NOT costumes. We must be sensitive to groups who have, in the past, been marginalized by mimicry and cultural appropriation during Halloween and other “dress up” events.
- 2) Gender identity and sexual orientation are not costumes. Gender switching and stereotyping for humour is hurtful and harmful.
- 3) Safety. Weapons, even plastic ones, will not be accepted at school. They represent a safety issue, and could cause harm when played with unsafely. Masks will not be accepted as we need to see students’ faces.
- 4) Gory and violent costumes are too scary for most of our younger students and are not appropriate for elementary school.
- 5) Let’s think about our ecological footprint. Is there a costume that could be reused or borrowed from a friend? Could you perhaps consider making your costume yourself from recycled materials?
